

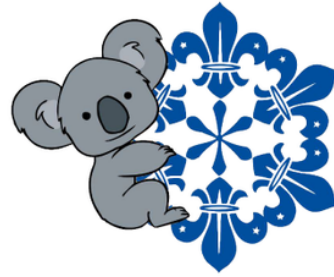

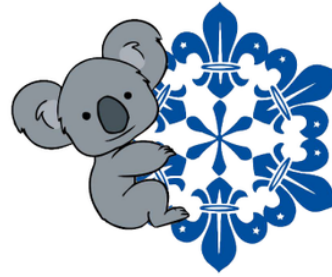

Packing – Day pack

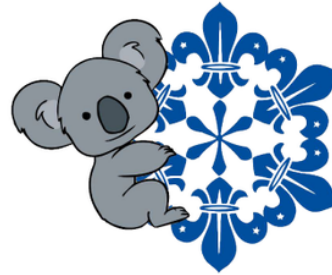
- Small backpack

(the one you want to take hiking with you is recommended)

– You should have the following things in your day pack:

- Passport + departure card
- Medications and any supporting documentation for them
- Small entertainment for the flight (book, music player)
- Your blue Contingent Shirt
- Toiletries
 - Remember all liquids you carry must be 100ml or less and stored in a small clear bag. More on this on the next slide
- Clear underwear (incase your luggage goes missing!)
- Empty drink bottle
- Extra soft stuff to make up the weight (jacket, shoes, sleeping bag)

Liquids, aerosols and gels

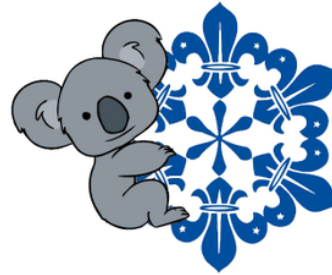
Toiletries

Your toiletries (any liquids, aerosols or gels) for the flight must all be:

- 100ml or under
- comfortably fit in a clear bag measuring 20x20cm (Such as the one shown)
- This includes:
lip balm, hand cream,
toothpaste, deodorant
(roll on and aerosol), and
perfume.

and gels

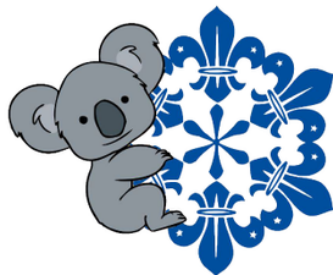

The 100ml liquid rule also applies to drink bottles

We suggest that you bring an empty drink bottle to the airport and then fill it once you are past security and customs.

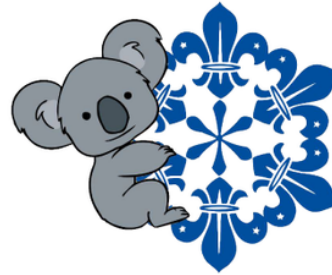
Stuff you will need at the airport

- Passport
- Green departure card
- Wear Scout uniform (including Aust scarf and name tag)
- Luggage (Day pack and check in luggage)
- Pen
- Contingent shirt

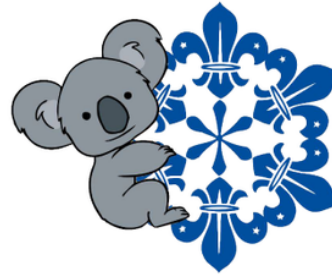
What will happen at the airport



KISC 2016
AUSTRALIAN CONTINGENT

- Check into the flight
 - you will need your passport
 - Keep your valuables close and don't leave luggage unattended
- Time with families
 - If not already, make sure green Departure Card is complete
- With Flight Captain, go through to International Departures
- Clear Security screening
 - any liquids over 100ml thrown out
- Clear customs
 - you will need your passport and green departure card
- Go to gate with Flight Captain
 - There may be some free time here
- Board plane
 - you need your passport and boarding pass
- **KEEP CHECKING YOU HAVE EVERYTHING. Don't unpack/lose anything!**

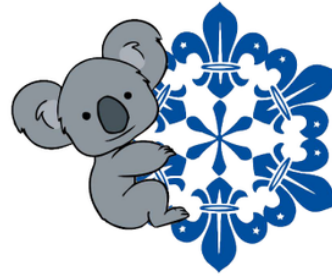
On the plane

- Board the plane and take note of your seat number so you know where you are going
- When you get to your seat, put your bag in the overhead compartment above your seat or under the seat in front of yours
- Put your seat belt on and relax, chat to your fellow contingent members and enjoy!

Stop over

- Before you land, make sure you have everything with you, especially your passport!!! You won't be getting back on the same plane!
- Once you've landed leave the plane and follow your Flight Captain through the airport to the Contingent Meeting Point.
- Make sure you know where you are sitting (it's on your other boarding pass) and board the plane like you did when you left Australia

- Leaving the plane - for good!
 - Make sure you have everything with you! Particularly your passport!
- Follow Flight Captains to immigration and customs.
- Show your passport at immigration
 - So make sure you have it with you.
- Collect your luggage (you should be able to see it because it will have your contingent tag on it) and move through customs – its not like in Australia and should be straight forward
- With Flight Captains, leave international arrivals
- Be greeted by the KISC2016 check in team! Do as they tell you!
